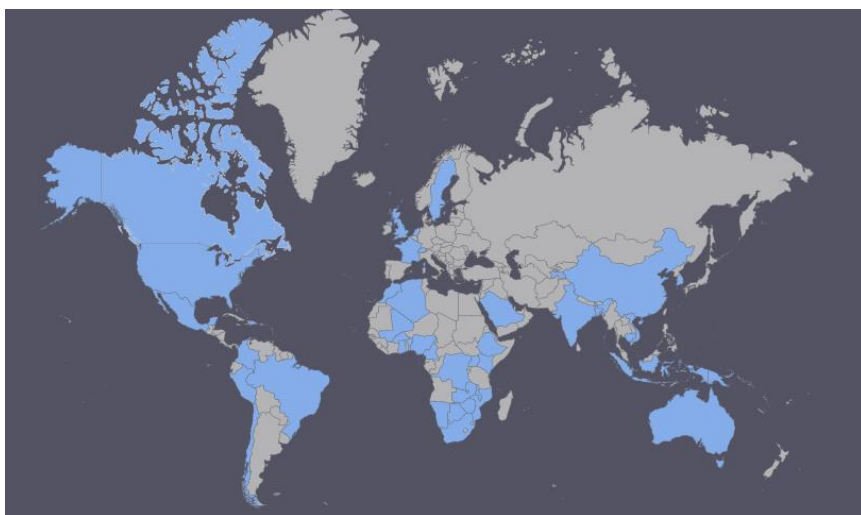
McGill University and McGill University Health Centre have exceptionally strong research groups and centres working on TB, HIV, and neglected tropical diseases. These centres collaborate each summer to hold short courses on infectious diseases. McGill Summer Institute courses feature internationally-known faculty, a focus on highly applicable new knowledge, and an opportunity to network with fellow global health professionals from around the world.

2016 at a glance....

~**400** participants from **46** countries took part in **5** courses offered over **two** weeks in the beautiful city of Montreal!

- Advanced TB Diagnostic Research
- Molecular and Genetic Epidemiology
- Tropical and Parasitic Diseases

Who attended the Summer Institute?*

A wide variety of participants travel to Montreal for the McGill Summer Institute. In 2016, **23%** were professors, academics, and researchers; **19%** were students and trainees; **12%** were business professionals/technical assistance agencies, and **11%** were healthcare workers. Others included participants from laboratory facilities, industry and advocacy and granting organizations.

2 of every 5 Summer Institute participants were from LMIC countries.

94% of Summer Institute participants would recommend the course they attended to their colleagues.
